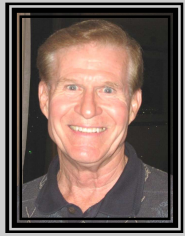




# Western Plastics Pioneers Newsletter

## *Pioneers Scholarship Program*

The Western Plastics Pioneers scholarship program is in its second year . The board of directors voted to increase the individual 2010 award to \$2,000.00. Fall mailings have been sent to various colleges as prepared by the SPE Foundation which administers the program on our behalf. Student applications are due by February 15, 2010 . Once reviewed by the SPE foundation for completeness and accuracy, all applications will be sent to the WPP board for review and selection.

The scholarship award is available to undergraduate students including those enrolled in associate degree or technical degree programs. Applicants attending a school in Arizona, California, Oregon or Washington who have demonstrated an interest in a plastics industry career will be considered for the \$2,000.00 award.

## **Constitution & Bylaws Revisions**

Our Pioneers Historian, Bob Halliday, tells me that there have been revisions to the Western Plastics Pioneers Constitution & Bylaws that eliminated the class of Trustee Memberships leaving only the class of Pioneer Memberships, but we cannot confirm it. If any of you elder Pioneers have a written copy of Constitution & Bylaws documents dated later than those referenced here, please let me know. It will help with the updating process.

The oldest document that I found, dated October 12, 1978, is entitled ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION of WESTERN PLASTICS MUSEUM AND PIONEERS, INC. This document establishes a nonprofit California corporation to establish and manage a museum to collect and display equipment, memorabilia, photos and mementos representing the history of plastics in the western half of the United States. The plastics Hall of Fame was created to honor the most deserving and renowned Pioneers. The Directors that signed this document were Irwin H. Groner, Norry Hastings and Claire Zweiback.

We have a copy of the 1980 and 1981 Revisions to the CONSTITUTION and BYLAWS of WESTERN PLASTICS MUSEUM AND PIONEERS, INC. The revisions define two classes of membership which are called Trustee Memberships and Pioneer Memberships. The fifteen (15) Trustee Members elect the eleven (11) Directors of the Corporation from their ranks and are responsible for managing the museum and all assets of the Corporation. Pioneer Memberships are unlimited for plastics industry participants of 25 years or more. Pioneer Members are entitled to participate in the activities of the Corporation. Duties of the President (CEO), Vice Presidents, Secretary, Treasurer and committees are defined. The President and the Secretary must be members of the Board of Directors, but the other officers need not be. These revisions have no signatures or official state certification, so I can only assume they were adopted and utilized for some period of time.

Documents from 1985 changed the name of the Corporation to WESTERN PLASTICS PIONEERS, INC. The Trustees document is entitled UNANIMOUS WRITTEN CONSENT OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF WESTERN PLASTICS MUSEUM AND PIONEERS, INC. signed by John Delmonte, Benb Lench, William J. Dewar, Charles Leighton, W. Brandt Goldsworthy, Elmer Meyer, Sr., Robert Halliday, Merrill R. Roth, Dr. Raymond B. Seymour, James H. Walcott, Christine Konecny, Charles C. Zimmerman and Thomas A. Lee.

Tallman. President Robert K. Halliday and Secretary Christine C. Konecny certified to the State of California of the name change to WESTERN PLASTICS PIONEERS, INC. Therefore, it became the official name in 1985.
